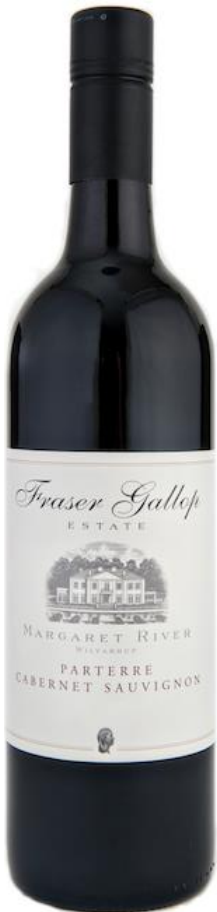


# Fraser Gallop

## ESTATE MARGARET RIVER

### 2014 Parterre Cabernet Sauvignon

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**Varieties:** 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot, 2% Merlot, 2% Malbec, 1% Cabernet Franc.

**Tasting note:** Vibrant and fresh with layers of black fruit on the palate. A sense of earth, herbal notes, chocolate and cedar. The finish is long and savoury, with gentle velvety tannins.

**Alcohol:** 14%

**pH:** 3.49

**Total Acidity:** 6.3g/L

**Residual Sugar:** 0.4g/L

**Harvest Date:** 14<sup>th</sup> March – 9<sup>th</sup> April 2014

**Oak:** 18 months in 33% new and older French oak barriques.

**Bottling Date:** November 2015

**Cellaring Potential:** Eminently drinkable now but will develop further complexity for up to 15 years.
